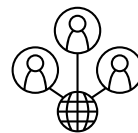
LEGISLATIVE CHANGES

- We have helped keep the non-forfeitable amount for people in insolvency and foreclosure at a manageable level.
- We participated in proposing changes to the Criminal Code to reduce the prison population.
- We have promoted amendments to the Bankruptcy Law to allow more debtors to manage debt relief.



RESEARCH AND INOVATIVE SOLUTIONS

- We have mapped the barriers to entry into insolvency for the long-term indebted and proposed systemic solutions.
- We trained 13 people with lived experience of prison to engage in systemic change.



COLLABORATION AND NETWORKING

- We are part of RESCALED, a European movement for small-scale, differentiated and community-integrated detention houses.



- We chair the committee of the Association of Organisations in Penal Affairs (AOOV).
- We are members of the Platform for Training Employment (PLATZ).
- Together with the Prison Service and Probation and Mediation Service, we organised the 7th annual Yellow Ribbon Run.
